Family Support Specialists (FSS)

Family Support Specialists offer guidance, advocacy, and encouragement to caregivers through the lens of lived experience navigating systems with their own children. This empathetic approach helps to remove barriers, enhance resiliency, and build collaborative relationships between families and systems.



Transition Age Youth (TAY) Peer Support Specialist

A TAY Peer Support Specialist (CPS) uses their own recovery experiences to engage and empower youth and young adults ages 14-26. Certified Peer Specialists are trained to help individuals find resources, advocate for themselves, resolve conflicts, and develop coping strategies and problem-solving methods. This intentional approach empowers individuals to thrive as they transition to independence.



Administrative Case Manager (ACM)

An Administrative Case Manager connects individuals with resources and coordinates their care to address specific needs. The ACM informs individuals of service options and advocates for them throughout the process, while focusing on their strengths and collaborating with services and systems to achieve the best possible outcome.
